### 1. COMPOSITION OF YOUR TEAM:

<u>Age</u>: Minimum age for workers is ~14 years. Also, a 1:5 ratio of 'adult' [age >18] to every 'youth' [age <18] is the minimum we can accept – we prefer something closer to 1:3.

MHM discourages bringing younger children. If you do bring younger children, their role needs to be limited to an age-appropriate work site with <u>parental</u> supervision. When we contact you for additional details, we'll ask for this team composition information.

<u>Skill level</u>: It is expected that each work group will have 'skilled' leaders who will be responsible for leading each work site crew, both in <u>doing the work</u> and in <u>doing it safely</u>. For each adult in the group, it will help greatly in assigning work sites if we know their various construction expertise and the level of that expertise. We also like to hear from you what types of <u>work you prefer to do</u>, and work you do <u>NOT</u> prefer to do. **In April, MATE will contact you** to discuss this information to help us in planning, and also request at least 10% of your team donation be sent then. We start client home visits in late April and begin to incur expenses.

#### 4. PROOF OF INSURANCE

MHM <u>requires</u> that every work group member MUST have personal liability and health insurance [Each group is responsible for verifying this]. <u>Further, we require that each work group send to MHM a certificate of group liability insurance coverage</u> [your church should have this coverage for mission trips].

#### 5. DONATION

MATE requests a fee of \$175-\$250 per worker on your team. The sliding scale has been employed to allow churches with fewer financial resources to still send teams to MATE. Churches that are able, pay the full \$250 per worker. Team fees are vital to MATE's operations to cover the costs of building materials, staff, and administrative costs. We ask that you submit a deposit of an estimated 10% of your expected team fees with your application, and pay the balance upon your arrival in Farmington. Please note that this amount may not correlate to the actual work your group may do – for example, painting sites cost less than sites that involve roofing repairs or new windows. Clearly, the more funds we receive, the more homes we can assist with repairs. We ask that you do whatever you can. Checks can be made payable to MATE-Housing Ministry and marked "Team Fees" in the memo line. As our commitment to homeowners is partly based on the number of volunteers we receive, we cannot refund any deposits should your group decide to cancel, as we made commitments based on your funding.
